Adopt-a-Trail Volunteer Duties
2018-2019



Thank you for helping in our Adopt-a-Trail Program. Keeping our trails in good condition is as important as their construction. The following list includes information about the volunteer commitment and the duties necessary to keep your assigned section of the trail in good order.

- **Volunteer Duties:** Pick up trash on and alongside the trail and dispose of it properly, cut back any impinging vegetation "Corridor Work", sweep trail surface, weed & water when necessary check trail amenities, (benches, signs, vegetation and surface), for damage or needs and make quarterly report.
- **Communicate with the Salida City Public Works Department:** Call or e-mail Will concerning help with trash bags, pick up and any trail concerns.
- **Assist with STERP:** The Salida Trail Ecological Restoration Program (STERP) involves periodic weeding, planting, watering and collection of seeds. Communicate with Buffy, STERP Coordinator.
- **Project Involvement:** Help in at least two projects each year. (May, Salida Green-up/Clean-Up and another trail work day. Communicate with Donna about scheduled work-days.
- **Make a two year commitment:** A volunteer sign with your name on it will be placed on your section. (Commitment Agreement attached)
- **Make Quarterly Reports:** Report to SPOT each quarter of the year in March, June, September and December. (Quarterly Report attached)
